Current issues addressed by INNONET's ongoing projects are:

- Establishment of a new Technology Competence Centre called TECHNONET in Győr as the next evolutionary step in INNONET's infrastructure development.

In frame of the project TECHNONET we aim to settle specialized shared services like rapid prototyping and a measurement laboratory infrastructure. Based on these services we seek day-to-day cooperation with local enterprises on a technological level. Thus aiding the development of a strong virtual competence network, joining regional technology experts, scientific institutions and innovative SME's.
